

Learning Lunch for Planners, Preservationists, and Developers

On Thursday, 28th February, the Rome-Floyd Planning Department, in cooperation with the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission, will hold a planner's lunch at Old Main School in Rome, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Leigh Burns, Outreach Program Manager, Preservation Planner, & Certified Local Government Program Coordinator, Historic Preservation Division, Georgia Department of Natural Resources will speak on historic preservation, planning, downtown development, and tourism. 1.5 CMU will be available for this session.

Kevin McAuliff, Environmental Planner with the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission; Secretary of the Whitfield County Historic Preservation Commission and of the non-profit Save Dalton's Battlefields; and member of the Administrative Committee of the Dalton Historic Preservation Commission and the board of Chieftains Museum will talk about a grassroots effort in Whitfield County to purchase and preserve important Civil War battlefield sites. 1.5 CMU will be available for this presentation.

During lunch, we will have a presentation on the history and importance of **Old Main School** (circa 1934), and the recent renovation for administrative offices and programs that serve disadvantaged youth in the community.

Driving Directions

From I75 North

- 1 Exit on to SR20 West. In Cartersville SR20 merges with US411
 - 2 In Rome, SR20 merges with US27 North
 - 3 US27 crosses the Etowah River
 - 4 After crossing the Etowah River, turn right at the 2nd traffic light on to SR293 (Broad St)
- Go to instruction A below...

From I75 South

- 1 Exit on to SR53 South
 - 2 In Rome, turn left on to SR1 Loop
 - 3 At the 2nd traffic light, turn right on to SR293 (Kingston Hwy)
 - 4 Kingston Hwy becomes MLK Blvd
 - 5 MLK Blvd passes Coosa Valley Fairgrounds (on left)
 - 6 After passing the fairgrounds, turn left at the second street on to Washington St
- Go to instruction C below...

From US27 South

- 1 In Rome, turn left on to US27 South (Turner McCall Blvd)
 - 2 After one mile, turn left on to SR293 (Broad St)
- Go to instruction A below...

From US27 North

- 1 In Rome US 27 crosses the Etowah River
 - 2 After crossing the Etowah River, turn right at the 2nd traffic light on to SR293 (Broad St)
- Go to instruction A below...

From SR101 North

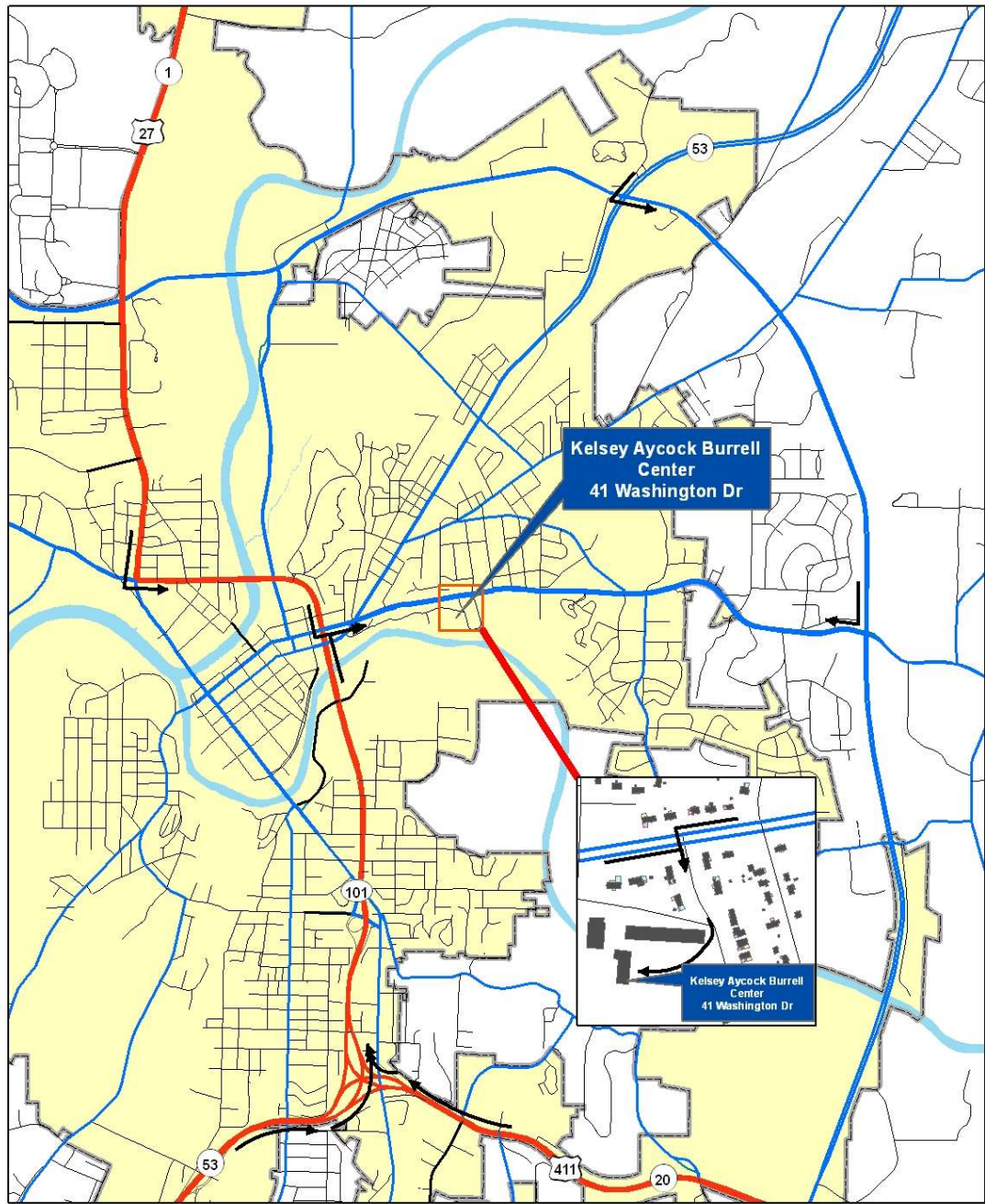
- 1 In Rome SR101 becomes Dean Ave
 - 2 Dean Ave merges with US27 North (Turner McCall Blvd)
 - 3 US27 crosses the Etowah River
 - 4 After crossing the Etowah River, turn right at the 2nd traffic light on to SR293 (Broad St)
- Go to instruction A below...

A After the 1st traffic light, SR293 goes over a viaduct

B After the viaduct turn right at the second street on to Washington St

C Take 2nd driveway on right, go to left of building

D Main entrance to conference is straight ahead, look for the wheelchair ramp
