


Population 2017: 874,340 (59% incr. from 1990)



2019 Survey: What Northwest Georgia Needs

- 1,860 responses between January-March 2019, all 15 counties
- Locate truck routes and industry on existing highways (43% and 59%)
- Blighted properties growing, affecting housing development (35-41%)
- Public transit available? 47% said no; 20% said Don't know
- Extend and connect bike and hiking trails (48% and 55%), connect to restaurants, lodging (61%)




