## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 9 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mass
- 2 transportation, so as to repeal provisions relating to the suspension of restrictions on the use
- 3 of annual proceeds from sales and use taxes by public transit authorities; to repeal provisions
- 4 relating to the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide for contingent repeal;
- 6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 9 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mass
- transportation, is amended by repealing in their entirety Code Sections 32-9-13 and 32-9-14,
- 11 relating to the suspension of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use
- 12 taxes by public transit authorities and the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta
- 13 Rapid Transit Authority, respectively.

14 SECTION 2.

- 15 This Act shall become effective on June 1, 2013, only if an Act providing for the suspension
- of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use taxes by the Metropolitan
- 17 Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority and reconstituting the board of directors of the Metropolitan
- 18 Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority is enacted at the 2013 regular session of the General
- 19 Assembly. Otherwise, this Act shall not become effective and shall stand repealed on June 1,
- 20 2013.

21 SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
